## Executive shakeup at Colorado mapping technology company

The chief executive officer and chief financial officer at a Douglas County mapping technology company have been axed.

Intermap Technologies Corp. said that CEO Todd Oseth and CFO Richard Mohr "are no longer with the company."

The new CEO is Patrick Blott, who is also chairman of the board. Michael Hoehn is the new CFO.

"These important organizational changes align Intermap's resources towards data acquisition, data integration, data fusion, and value-added analytics, where Intermap is a global leader, and trusted partner for government and commercial customers," Blott said in a statement.

It was only a few months ago that the Denver Business Journal profiled Intermap, reporting that it "landed a \$175 million multi-year contract that's likely to transform the business and bring back dozens of local jobs to a business that's remade itself after cutting most of its jobs in 2011."
